5000 ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS ARRIVE IN HAIFA  
AFTER FIGHT WITH BRITISH NAVAL PARTY

AT 5,000 ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS, A THIRD OF WHICH WERE CHILDREN, REACHED HAIFA, PALESTINE, ON JULY 18 ABOARD THEIR SHIP, THE 'PRESIDENT WARFIELD' - RENAMED HAGANAH SHIP EXODUS 1947. AFTER A FIGHT WITH A BOARDING PARTY OF BRITISH NAVAL OFFICERS, THEY WERE PEACEFULLY UNLOADED TO VESSELS FOR TRANSIT TO CYPRUS. THE DEPARTURE OF REFUGEES WAS WATCHED BY JUDGE PER-ALMUNDUR SANDSTROM, CHAIRMAN OF UNITED NATIONS SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON PALESTINE AND M. STANLEY JUDGE, JUGOSLAV DELEGATE. SEVERAL REFUGEES WERE INJURED WHEN A CLASH OCCURRED BETWEEN THE BRITISH NAVAL PARTY WERE BOARDING THE 'PRESIDENT WARFIELD'. THE REFUGEE SHIP SUSTAINED STRUCTURAL DAMAGE WHEN SHE ATTEMPTED TO TAKE EVASIVE ACTION.
